Section 1. Data Committee Overview

1.1 Committee Problem Statement

- Committee purpose is to identify, monitor, and publish results on institutional effectiveness measures, key performance indicators, and metrics for NECSS strategic goals.
- Committee will assist other committees in establishing protocols and procedures to measure goals, i.e., use of Stackable Career tool, use of Program of Study tool.

1.2 Committee Goals and Objectives

Define how to monitor:

- P-20 curriculum alignment and transfer articulation
- Increase in percentage of first-time, full-time freshmen from sending high schools who begin in credit-bearing courses.

Establish metric to measure increases in:

- Number of first generation students who aspire and achieve to post-secondary degrees.
- Number of students of color who aspire and achieve post-secondary degrees.
- Number of males who achieve post-secondary degrees.

Measure:

- Increase in overall graduation rates
- Reduction in attrition
- Decrease in student achievement gaps

Assist other committees in developing evaluation plans to measure their goals including:

- Stackable Career tool
- Program of Study and Academic Pathway tools
- Number of post-secondary credentials earned
- Number of dual credits earned
- Integration of career readiness skills into education and training programs.

1.3 Committee Scope
