# 5. Strategic-Discussion and Sharing

- a. MATH 080 Project-D. Schuler
  - D. Schuler stated passing rates for students taking the MTH 080 course have not improved; therefore, D214 will continue to offer the MTH 080 course but NOT the MTH 080 final exam in their schools. D214 students will take the final exam in Math using the COMPASS testing.
  - D. Schuler, T. Leonard, and N. Robb voiced concerns about the different standards used by Harper for Harper students and high school students.
  - K. Ender proposed that Harper faculty and all districts work together to develop revised unit tests and new final exam for the MTH 080 course.
  - K. Ender stated that the problem with the MTH 080 final exam should have been brought to the Coordinating Council. He proposed the Council develop a solution to this issue.
  - D. Cates inquired about the status of the ENG Alignment Project.
  - T. Busch stated D211 is piloting the ENG project in its five schools this fall. The curriculum for this project will align with Harper's ENG 100 class. High school students who pass this course with an A, B, or C grade will be proficient and the prerequisite will be met for placement in the first credit bearing English course at Harper.

#### b. Conceptual Design for Early College-Coordinating Council

- The Council presented a Conceptual Design Program to increase College and Career Readiness.
- The pilot program would begin with Bridge Program students (Excel III, AVID, Adelante, REACH).
- Highlights of Presentation Included:
  - 1. Core Foundation Data
  - 2. Analysis of Bridge Programs
  - 3. Link between 15 credit hours earned while in high school and college completion rate-"Power of 15".
  - 4. Possibility of students completing six years of college in five years-"6 in 5"
  - 5. Resolve Policy and Fiscal Issues.

All Board members agreed the Coordinating Council move forward with this "Conceptual Design for Early College." Any policy or fiscal issues can be presented to Board as they arise.
