# **Section 1. Student Support Committee Overview**

### 1.1 Committee Purpose

- Early intervention teams to identify students at risk, including but not limited to, students with office discipline referral histories, academic achievement, attendance, test scores.

#### Focus-Stackable Certificates vs. Transferable Courses

- Students/parents/counselors/teachers must be able to easily identify options for early college credit regarding impact of core academic standing and financial aid.
- Students/parents/counselors/teachers need to understand:
  - o Certificates
    - Harper (non-industry)
    - Industry (awarded certificates)
  - o AAS with transfer options to specific 4-year schools
  - AS Degrees

#### Focus-Career Identification and Preparation vs. Admission to College

- Identify eventual CAREER goal. Many secondary and postsecondary students need assistance through career guidance to identify career goals. COLLEGE completion is one tool amongst many that may help achieve the career goal.
- POS study tool must be easy to navigate and understand.

#### 1.2 Committee Goals and Objectives

- Committee will focus on high school student seamless transitioning to postsecondary
- Provide/develop proposal for counselor training on trade schools, military, apprenticeships, dual credit, etc.
